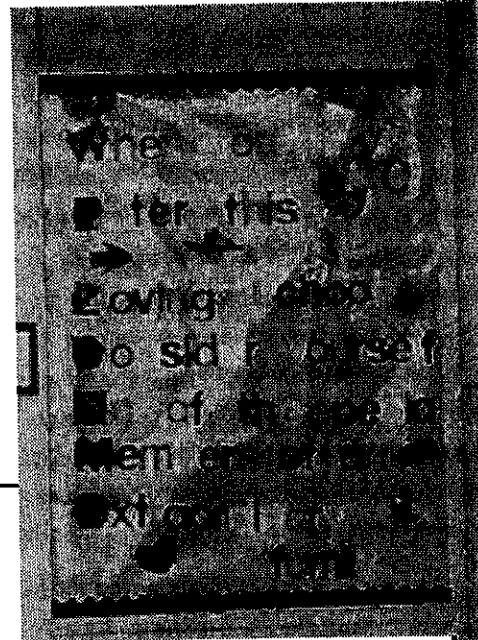


PTA NEWS

Drop Off and Pick Up

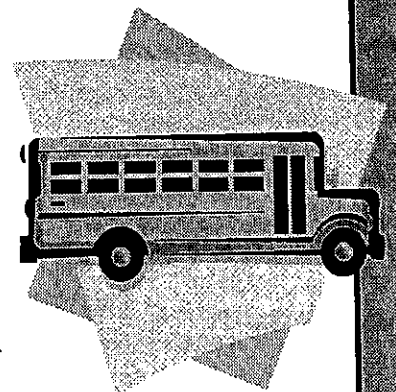
Drop off and pick up can be tricky times of the day at any school and we are surely no different. Please remember that our students' safety is the most important consideration for us.

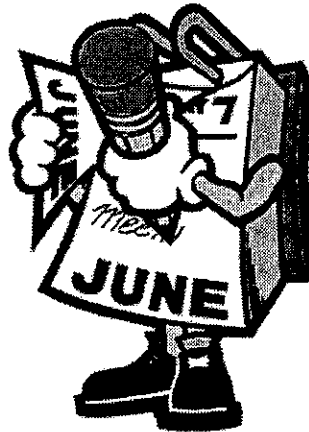
