

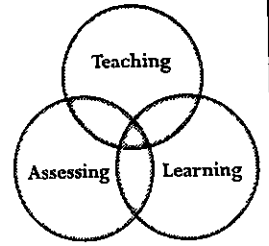

Maine Education Assessment (MEA)



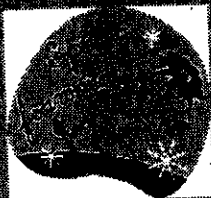
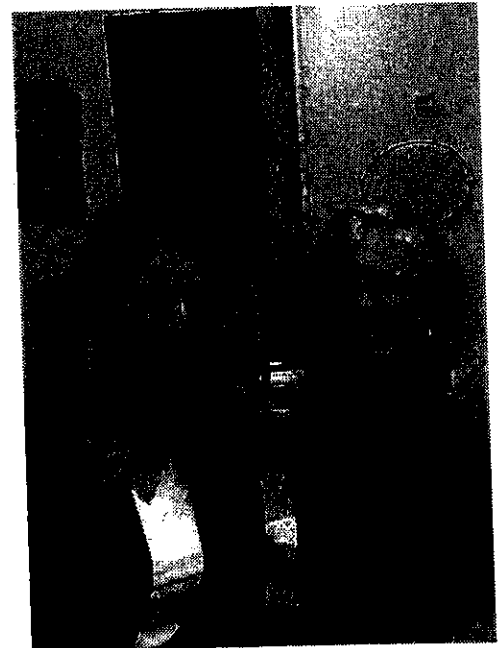
HES students in grades 3 and 4 are preparing to take the Maine Education Assessment (MEA) for math and literacy (reading, written language skills, and an informational essay). Students will have a chance to practice logging in and getting familiar with the test format and online tools before the computer-based assessment begins on March 19, continuing through April 13.

The test will be taken in 7 separate sessions. During this time, it's important to avoid unnecessary absences and ensure that your students arrive at school well-rested and ready to do their best. Students will need to make up any missed sessions during the four-week test window.

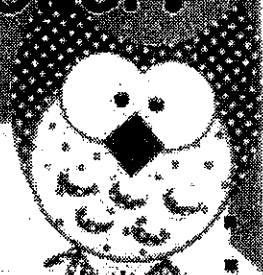
The MEA, combined with other information, can help us better understand the progress of our students. The tests are aligned to the content and skills outlined in Maine's College and Career Readiness Standards, to help guide instruction in Maine's classrooms.

Meet the Substitute Teacher!



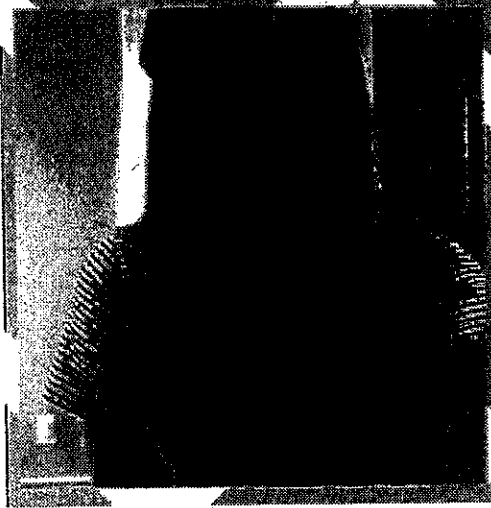
Hello first graders and their families!

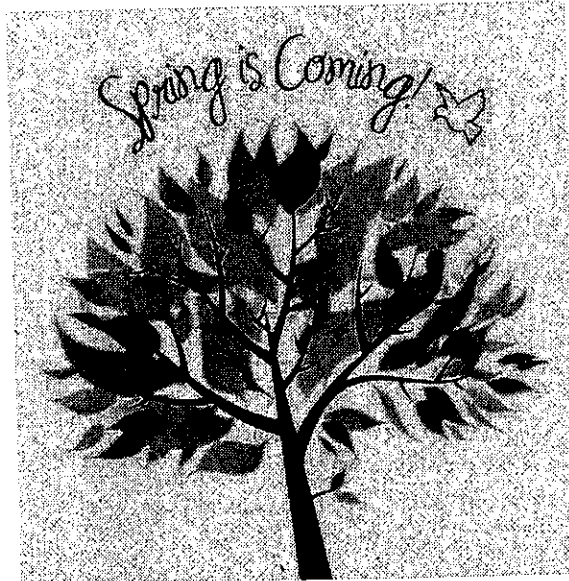
